as we thank the LORD once again for the empty tomb. The truths

of God's word will unfold before our eyes as we learn more and more about Israel - the Past, the Present, and the Prophetic. We believe that this is one of the best tours available and we are offering it at a minimum cost. We will enjoy first class hotels, three nourishing meals each day, and all travel fare. Look through this brochure for more details regarding the exciting places that we will visit.

Day 1 - DEPART USA

This afternoon we will depart Atlanta, GA for our flight to Tel Aviv, Israel

Day 2 - ARRIVE TEL AVIV

We will arrive at Ben Gurion Airport this afternoon. Our TEMPLETON TOURS representative will meet us at the airport and assist us with our luggage and with customs. Once we are on the bus we will meet our guide and drive to Joppa. There we will view the house of Simon the Tanner before continuing to Tel Aviv for dinner and overnight (D).

Day 3 - CAESAREA - MOUNT CARMEL - MEGIDDO - HAIFA - TIBERIAS

Depart Tel Aviv and proceed north along the coast to Caesarea where Peter converted the centurion and Paul was imprisoned. Here we will visit the Roman theater, the Crusader city, the Byzantine Street, and the water aqueduct. We'll continue along the Mediterranean coast to Mount Carmel. We will visit the Carmelite Monastery where Elijah hid in a cave from King Ahab. After lunch we will travel to Megiddo, one of Solomon's chariot cities. At Megiddo we will ascend the tel and see the excavations, the magnificent water system, and look over the Valley of Armageddon (Revelation 16:16). We'll continue our ascent up Mount Carmel to the beautiful city of Haifa to view the Mediterranean Sea. Afterwards we will drive through the Galilee region to our hotel on the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight (B/L/D).

Day 4 - SEA OF GALILEE - CURSI - CAESAREA PHILIPPI - MOUNT OF BEATITUDES - CAPERNAUM - PRIMACY OF PETER - GALILEE EXPERIENCE

After breakfast we take a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee.

While on the boat we'll pause for a brief worship service and remember the many miracles our Lord performed in this area. We'll dock at Ein Gev, then proceed to the village of Cursi where Jesus cast demons into the swine. After lunch of the world-famous St. Peter's Fish we'll travel into the Golan Heights to Caesarea Philippi, one of the sources of the Jordan River. Our next stop will be at the Mount of Beatitudes, a place to commemorate the Sermon on the Mount. After a short worship service we will drive to Capernaum to see the remains of Peter's house and the ancient synagogue. We will also visit the nearby Church of the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes as well as the Primacy of Peter where Jesus asked Peter, "Lovest thou me?" three times (John 21). On our return to Tiberias we will stop at the "Galilee Experience", a multi-media presentation about the history of Israel and the Galilee area (B/L/D).

Day 5 - JORDAN RIVER - CANA - NAZARETH - GIDEON SPRINGS - BET SHE'AN - JERICHO - JERUSALEM

This morning we'll leave Galilee and begin our journey to Jerusalem. Our first stop will be at the Jordan River Baptismal site. We continue through the Galilee region and drive through Cana where Jesus performed his first miracle, then continue on to Nazareth, boyhood home of Jesus to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation and the Church of St. Joseph. Then we'll visit Gideon Springs where Gideon chose his army to fight the Midianites. After a brief devotion we will visit Bet She'an and see the excavations of the city where the bodies of Saul and Jonathan were hung after their deaths (1 Samuel 31:12). Then we begin a journey through the Jordan Valley to Jericho. If the situation permits, we will enter Jericho to see the excavations of the ancient walls, view the Mount of Temptation, and Elisha's Spring. After lunch we will begin our ascent to Jerusalem. On the way, we'll get a glimpse of "the Valley of the Shadow of Death". Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel in Jerusalem (B/L/D).

Day 6 - MASADA - EIN GEDI - QUMRAN - JERUSALEM

We have an exciting day ahead of us as we travel to the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on the earth (1320 feet below sea level). We will first visit the mountain fortress of Masada, truly a remarkable piece of history. We will ascend by cable car to visit the magnificent ruins of the fortress where the Jewish zealots made the last stand of the Judean revolt against Rome. Today the remains of Herod's buildings, palaces, storehouses, cisterns, and a 6th Century Byzantine church are still in view. Then we'll drive to Ein Gedi, a green oasis in the middle of the desert, and see the area where David hid while fleeing from King Saul. Afterwards we will drive to Qumran to see

the caves where they hid some of the Dead Sea Scrolls. On our way back to Jerusalem we will stop at the traditional Good Samaritan Inn, then return to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight (B/L/D).

Day 7 - MOUNT OF OLIVES - WALKING TOUR - BETHLEHEM

This morning we'll begin our tour on the Mount of Olives. The Mount of Olives offers us a breathtaking view of the city of Jerusalem. While we are here, our guide will point out all of the important sites of Jerusalem. Then we'll enter the Old City of Jerusalem for the first time and embark on an exciting walking tour! If conditions permit, we will ascend to the Temple Mount where the Jewish temple stood until its destruction in 70 A.D. If possible, we will walk on the Temple Mount and pass the Dome of the Rock Mosque built over the rock where Abraham prepared to sacrifice Isaac. We'll also pass the Al-Aqsa Mosque and the Golden Gate. Then we'll visit the beautiful Crusader Church dedicated to St. Anne and the nearby Pool of Bethesda. Time permitting we will visit the Citadel or Tower of David near the Jaffa Gate. Later this morning we will drive to Bethlehem and if the situation permits, we will eat lunch, then visit the Church of the Nativity, built over the cave of Christ's birth, as well as the Shepherd's Field and plains of Boaz. We will also see the ancient crafts of Bethlehem, dating back to Crusader times. Time permitting we will visit one of the famous Bethlehem gift shops before returning to our hotel (B/L/D).

Day 8 - SOUTH WALL EXCAVATIONS - WESTERN WALL TUNNEL - PILATE'S PALACE - JEWISH QUARTER - ROMAN CARDO - TEMPLE TREASURES MUSEUM - UPPER ROOM - TOMB OF KING DAVID - SHRINE OF THE BOOK - MODEL CITY - EIN KAREM

Today we return to the Old City for another exciting tour. We will enter through the Dung Gate to see the Southern Wall excavations. Here we will stand on the very steps where Jesus taught on several occasions. Then we will visit the Western Wall and Tunnel excavation site to see the ancient chiseled cisterns, narrow passages, an arch that supported the bridge across the Tyropean Valley, and the original foundational stones upon which the Western (Wailing) Wall was built. Our next stop will be at Antonia Fortress, site of Pilate's Palace. We'll pass the traditional 14 Stations of the Cross, walk on the Via Dolorosa, and see part of the old colorful bazaar. We will continue our walk through the Old City to the restored Jewish Quarter and the Roman Cardo. Then we'll visit the Temple Treasures Museum and see some of the instruments that will be used in the next Jewish temple. We then proceed to Mount

Zion to visit the Upper Room and the traditional Tomb of King David. After lunch we will visit the Model City, a 1:50 scale model of Jerusalem as it was during Jesus' time on earth. We'll also visit the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are kept and enjoy some free time in the Israeli museum. Afterwards we will drive to Ein Karem to visit the birthplace of John the Baptist, then return to our hotel for dinner and overnight (B/L/D).

Day 9 - VALLEY OF ELAH - BETH SHEMESH - OBEDEDOM - NEOT KEDUMIM - EMMAUS - YAD V-SHEM

After breakfast we will drive a short distance from Jerusalem to visit to the Valley of Elah, site of David's battle with Goliath. Afterwards we will travel to Bet Shemesh and Obededom to see the area where the ark of the covenant was returned on a cow-pulled cart from the land of the Philistines (I Samuel 6). We will also visit the Biblical nature reserve of Neot Kedumum. Here we will see hundreds of Biblical and Talmudic plants, wild and domesticated animals, ancient olive and wine presses, threshing floors, cisterns, and ritual baths. We'll then drive to Emmaus, the village where Jesus walked with Cleopas and his friend after the resurrection (Luke 24:13ff). After lunch we will visit the Yad V'Shem, a museum built in memory of the 6,000,000 Jews murdered by the Nazis in World War II. Time permitting we will enjoy some time at leisure to shop in the Old City or relax at our hotel (B/L/D).

Day 10 - GETHSEMANE - POOL OF SILOAM - HOUSE OF CAIAPHAS - CALVARY - GARDEN TOMB

This is our last day in the Holy Land but it is a day you will never forget. We begin with a visit to the Garden of Gethsemane. We will pause here for a private worship service and meditate in the area where Jesus had His agony and was betrayed. From this vantage point we also get an excellent view of the Eastern gate. As we reflect on Jesus' great sacrifice for our sins, we can look ahead with great anticipation as we await his imminent return. After our worship service we will walk through the Valley of the Tombs. Along the way we will pass the traditional tombs of Absalom and Ezra. After our walk we will visit the recent archaeological discovery of the Pool of Siloam. This is the place where Jesus told the blind man to wash the mud from his eyes so he could see. Afterwards, we will travel a short distance to the House of Caiaphas where Peter denied Christ three times. After lunch we'll visit Calvary and the Garden Tomb, a peaceful spot where we will have a private worship service as we reflect on Christ's crucifixion, burial, and resurrection. After our service we will return to the hotel for dinner and overnight (B/L/D).

Day 11 - JERUSALEM - USA

Today our memorable journey and Holy Land pilgrimage comes to an end. We will transfer to the airport in Tel Aviv and board the plane for our return flight home. In flight we can fellowship with our friends and remember the many things we shared together (B).



DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$250.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$750.00 per person is due November 8, 2010. The final payment is due no less than 60 days prior to the departure date of the tour (January 8, 2011). Payment can be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments will only be accepted for the full price of the tour cost at the time of booking. Reservations received after December 8, 2010 may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.
